

SL001 - Flesh Latex



Concealing Edges

Glue the Woochie appliance or Bald Cap as described in their respective instructions. Tear a Cinema Secrets White Makeup Sponge in half. Texture the sponge by picking at it with your fingers, making the surface uneven. Dip this end of the sponge in Flesh Latex, and in a stippling motion, apply it all around the edge of the Bald Cap or prosthetic appliance, overlapping onto the skin about ¼" from the edge. Let dry. You can use a hairdryer set on low to speed up the process. Repeat for a better coverage. Use Cinema Secrets Colorless Powder to reduce tackiness.

Old Age Effect

You will need Flesh Latex, a White Makeup Sponge, Colorless Powder and a Powder Puff. Begin by pulling the skin beneath the eye area, downward towards the jaw. While holding, apply a thin coat of latex to this area. Be careful not to get latex anywhere near the eyes or eyelashes. Let dry. You may use a hair dryer on low to speed the drying time. Set with Colorless Powder, and release. Repeat this process until you get the desired amount of wrinkles. Usually 2 to 3 coats will do. Repeat this process on other areas of the face and neck, making sure to work on small areas at a time, and to always stretch the skin from the center of the face outwards. Once you have achieved the desired effect, color using Cinema Secrets Cream Makeup.

Removal

Apply a warm, wet towel to face and neck to loosen the latex. Rub, in a circular motion, small amounts of Cinema Secrets Makeup & Adhesive Remover to the made-up areas until all the latex has been removed. Finish by applying a moisturizer to your skin.
