



TD001 - Face & Body Wax

Blocking Out Eyebrows

Brush a small amount of Cinema Secrets Spirit Gum into the brow hair, tacking it until sticky. This will create a solid base for the wax to hold in place. Remove a small amount of wax from the container using a spatula or popsicle stick. Roll it into a small ball using your fingers. Press into the eyebrow and smooth to the desired texture. A little alcohol or hair gel on your finger tips will keep the wax from sticking to your fingers and will help smooth it out. Seal the wax using Cinema Secrets Wax and Prosthetic Sealer. Use Cinema Secrets Cream Makeups to color as desired.

Creating 3D Effects

Brush and tack a small amount of Spirit Gum on the area where the wax will be applied. Add small amounts of cotton fibers to the spirit gum by dabbing it with a cotton ball. These fibers will help the wax hold in place. Remove a small amount of wax from the container using a spatula or popsicle stick. Roll it into a small ball using your fingers. Press wax onto the cottoned spirit gum area, and form to the desired shape. A little alcohol or hair gel on your finger tips will keep the wax from sticking to your fingers and will help smooth it out. Seal the wax using Cinema Secrets Wax and Prosthetic Sealer. Use Cinema Secrets Cream Makeups to color as desired.

Removal

Apply a warm, wet towel to face and neck to loosen the wax. Rub, in a circular motion, small amounts of Cinema Secrets Makeup & Adhesive Remover to the made-up areas until all the wax has been removed. Finish by applying a moisturizer to your skin.
